- Cumulative GPA of 2.5
- C or better in Comp I, Comp II, and College Algebra

- Two recommendation forms from educators
- Verification of 40 hours of work experience with children or youth
- Signed Dispositions form
- Proof of liability insurance
- Licensure information form
- Purchase 4 year subscription to Taskstream by Watermark
- Test scores: ACT 21 composite, equivalent SAT, **or** Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators scores of 156 reading, 162 writing, 150 mathematics
- Completion of the online orientation module (after adm. to TE)

## **Phase III: Teaching Internship**

- Minimum of 90 semester credit hours
- Completion of ALL professional education courses with a C or better
- Minimum overall 2.5 GPA
- Submit application and advisor agreement to OCFBI (318 Allen)
- Take the Praxis Subject Assessment and the Praxis Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT)
